

Memorandum of Understanding
For
Honors Program Transfers
Between
Missouri State University
and
Ozarks Technical Community College

This agreement is made and entered into as of the 7th day of April, 2009, by and between Ozarks Technical Community College (OTC) and Missouri State University (MSU).

The Honors College of Missouri State University will offer participation in their program to students of the Honors Program of Ozarks Technical Community College.

Application Process

OTC Honors Program students who complete the requirements of the OTC Honors Program are eligible for acceptance to the MSU Honors College. OTC students who complete credits with OTC's Honors Program but do not graduate from the Program are also eligible for Missouri State University's Honors College, provided they have a cumulative grade point average of 3.25 or higher.

OTC Honors students will be required to follow transfer application requirements for admission to Missouri State University as transfer students.

General Requirements

OTC Honors students who choose to participate in MSU's Honors College must meet all the requirements of MSU's honors program in order to graduate in the Honors College. Specifically, the MSU Honors College program requires nineteen hours of general honors course work. These nineteen hours must include a three hour course that addresses MSU's public affairs mission, and this course must be completed through MSU.

OTC Honors Program students who transfer into the MSU Honors College will also be eligible for the MSU Honors College Departmental Honors program.

Articulation of Coursework

HON 101 *Honors Seminar* with the OTC Honors Program will fulfill the MSU UHC 110 *Freshman Honors Seminar* course. With the exception of HON 101, courses offered in the OTC Honors Program are Honors sections of general education courses with existing articulation agreements.

Miscellaneous


OTC Honors Program students are required to apply to Missouri State University and follow application requirements for admission to MSU as transfer students. The student is responsible for all application and incidental fees. Interested students may apply for federal financial aid as well as MSU departmental and university scholarships.

Review Date

This agreement is up for review after three years.
