

**CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT

This Contractual Agreement, by and between:

hereinafter referred to as "**CONTRACTING AGENCY,**"

and:

**OZARKS TECHNICAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
1001 Chestnut Expressway  
Springfield, MO 65802-3625**

hereinafter referred to as "**COOPERATING AGENCY,**" hereby agree as follows:

The **CONTRACTING AGENCY** shall be administered in accordance with the "Minimum Standards of Accredited Programs of Professional Nursing and Licensure of Professional Nurses in Missouri," of the Missouri State Board of Nursing, in force at the date of this Contractual Agreement, or as they may afterward be changed.

That the **CONTRACTING AGENCY** and the **COOPERATING AGENCY** will meet annually to review the Contractual Agreement and make necessary changes to facilitate the transfer of OTC ASN graduates, the following **Admission Procedure for Transfer of OTC ASN Graduates to St. John's College of Nursing and Health Sciences, Southwest Baptist University** will be utilized:

- ✓1. Advisement for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing program will be conducted by both the OTC and St. John's College of Nursing and Health Sciences faculty as desired by pre-BSN nursing students.
2. Admission requirements for OTC Associate of Science in Nursing graduates of 2009 and after include:
  - a. Attend an admissions meeting with the Admissions Coordinator.
  - b. Schedule an appointment with the Director of Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program after all official transcripts from OTC and/or other colleges or universities have been received at the St. John's College of Nursing and Health Sciences Admissions office.
  - c. GPA of 2.5 or above.
  - d. Current Missouri RN licensure.

3. Completion of the ASN program at OTC will meet the following degree requirements of the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program:

BIO 2204 or four (4) credit hours of Anatomy and Physiology I  
BIO 3304 or four (4) credit hours of Anatomy and Physiology II  
BIO 2243 Nutrition (3 credit hours)  
CHE 1104 or four (4) credit hours of an equivalent chemistry course  
ENG 1113 or three (3) credit hours of an equivalent English composition course or ENG 1123 Honors Composition  
PSY 1013 or three (3) credit hours of General Psychology  
PSY 3063 or three (3) credit hours of Growth and Development course  
BIO 2213 or three (3) credit hours of Microbiology  
POL 1113 American Government (3 credit hours)  
MAT 0123 Intermediate Algebra (3 credit hours)

4. Other General Education degree requirements that need to be met for the BSN degree include:

ECO 2003 Life Econ or ECO 2023 Microeconomics or ECO 2033 Macroeconomics (fully online or correspondence) (3 credit hours)  
ENG 2213 English Composition (3 credit hours)  
COM 1103 Fundamentals of Speech or COM 2393 Interpersonal Communication (3 credit hours)  
One course from Fine Arts: FAR 1003, 1013, 1023, 1033, MUS 1633 (3 credit hours)  
One course from Cultural Studies area (met by NUR 3393) (3 credit hours)  
Mathematics: MAT 1143 College Algebra (3 credit hours)  
HIS 2213 US History I or HIS 2223 US History II (offered by correspondence) (3 credit hours)

5. The nursing courses required for BSN degree after acceptance to the BSN program include:

NUR 3373 Nursing as Ministry (3 credit hours)  
NUR 3453 Spirituality in Nursing (3 credit hours)  
NUR 3393 Transcultural Nursing (3 credit hours)  
NUR 3383 Gerontological Nursing (3 credit hours)  
NUR 4953 Nursing Elective (3-4 credit hours)  
NUR 3303 Health Assessment (3 credit hours)  
NUR 4434 Nursing Administration and Leadership (4 credit hours)  
NUR 4344 Theories and Research (4 credit hours)  
NUR 4404 Community Health (4 credit hours)  
NUR 4442 Capstone (2 credit hours)

6. The specific BSN program requirements include:

BIO 4404 Pathophysiology (4 credit hours)  
PSY 3243 Statistics (3 credit hours)

7. Additional graduation requirements for BSN program include:

- BIB 1013 Old Testament History (3 credit hours)
- BIB 1023 New Testament History (3 credit hours)
- HPE 1162 Physical Fitness/Wellness (correspondence course) (2 credit hours)
- SPF 2012 Spiritual Formation (Met by NUR 3453) (3 credit hours)

The above procedure will be followed for OTC ASN graduates who meet the above requirements and apply for admission to the St. John's College of Nursing and Health Sciences BSN program. It is recommended that applications be received prior to graduation from the OTC ASN program.

This agreement may be adapted to changing curriculum requirements. Every effort should be made to notify students at least one semester, but preferably two semesters, prior to a change in this agreement.

All changes in this agreement must be approved by the Dean of St. John's College of Nursing and Health Sciences, Southwest Baptist University, and the Dean of Allied Health, Ozarks Technical Community College.


