Testing dates are subject to change and are scheduled by appointment only, no walk-ins are accepted. Please call the Career Center Counseling and Assessment at 447-6983 to schedule your assessment date and time. Schedule your assessments early as possible as there is limited space available for testing and students are scheduled on a first-come first-serve basis. Students must be prompt to the testing session as no students will be admitted to the testing lab once the testing session has begun.

Pre-admission tests are administered in the Career Center Counseling and Assessment lab located in ICE, Room 116. There is a \$10.00 assessment fee, which must be paid at the Cashier's office, Information Commons Building – second floor, prior to your arrival for the assessment. Please bring your receipt for the assessment fee and a photo ID to the Counseling & Assessment office the day of your assessment. The preadmission testing will consist of four different assessments:

1. Bennett: a mechanical reasoning test - assesses understanding of mechanical concepts
2. Wonderlic: a cognitive abilities test - assesses problem-solving skills
3. SAGE : a finger dexterity test - assesses the ability to work with small objects
4. TAP: a finger dexterity test using small tools - assesses the ability to manipulate small objects using small tools

The assessment process takes approximately two hours to complete. There is a minimum score for each unit of the assessment for each program. The results will be mailed and should be received within 7 days following the assessments. If results are not received within 7 days please call the Counseling and Assessment staff at 447-6983. Any applicant not receiving the minimum score on any one unit (or units) will have an opportunity to retake that unit (or units). An appointment must be scheduled with the Counseling and Assessment staff at 447-6983 to retake the assessment. Appointments are made at the discretion of Counseling and Assessment staff.

Please note: Applicants may take any of the individual tests no more than twice in twelve consecutive months if test results are not at the minimum score range. Applicants cannot retest if results were in the acceptable score range. Applicants cannot retake the Wonderlic Scholastic Level Exam or Bennett Mechanical Comprehension Test within the same day of the original assessment. To retake the assessment at the appointed time the \$10 fee must be paid in advance and the receipt presented along with a picture form of identification.

Surgical Technology Admission Criteria

Surgical Technology Program applicants must complete the following assessments no later than February 15. The application deadline for the program is March 1.

- Bennett Mechanical Comprehension Test
 - Required Score: Thirty-five (35) or Higher
- Wonderlic Scholastic Level Achievement Exam
 - Required Score: Sixteen (16) or Higher
- System for Assessment and Group Evaluation (SAGE)
 - Required Score: Three (3) or Higher
- Talent Assessment Program (TAP) Dexterity with Small Tools
 - Required Score: 10% or Higher
