

SUPPLIES FOR WATERCOLOR CLASS TAUGHT BY ALICIA FARRIS:

Paper

2 pieces of Arches 140 lb cold press – 22” x 30”

Paint

Any watercolor paint tubes you have-
and/or - I recommend the following colors:

Alizarine crimson

Ultramarine blue

Paynes gray

Lemon Yellow, Hansa Yellow or aureolin

Raw sienna

Burnt sienna

Sap green

(no white or black necessary)

or

set of tube paints with red, yellow, blue, raw sienna and green

Watercolor brushes

(try to get good ones that come to a point)

I recommend #2 round, #6 or #8 round, #10 round, and ¾” - 1 inch flat

Misc.

palette with large mixing areas – can be a white plate – not Styrofoam or paper

paper towels

large cup or plastic container for water

masking tape

pencil

gum eraser

photos for subject matter

sketch book

board to attach paper – piece of foam core will work. Approximately 16” x 20”

hair dryer
