Missouri's community colleges work together through the Missouri Community College Association (MCCA) in support of a common legislative agenda.

MCCA respectfully asks the Governor and legislature to:

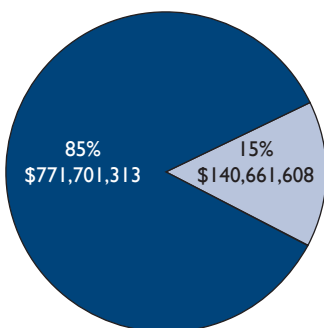
- Maintain current levels of state support for community colleges. Any increase or decrease in funding should reflect the reality of where most Missouri students go to college. Today, community colleges educate more in-state, undergraduate students than any other sector of higher education.
- Keep the A+ promise. Students who meet the requirements to receive A+ scholarships should receive what they believe they were promised: full tuition and fees at a community college or technical school. However, in recognition of limited state funds, MCCA supports policy-driven, student-centered approaches that limit the pool of students allowed to receive state scholarships to those who have truly met the challenges the programs were established to address.



- Continue efforts to identify reliable, sustainable sources of funding for capital improvements and renovations. Capital investment is particularly essential to the state's community colleges, which have experienced record enrollment growth for each of the last five years.
- Support the New Jobs Training Program, which offers reimbursement for the training and costs associated with the creation of new jobs.
- Support the Missouri Science and Innovation Reinvestment Act (MOSIRA), which reinvests funds generated by science and innovation companies into economic development tools, such as workforce development programs.

(Comparison of Operating Budgets)

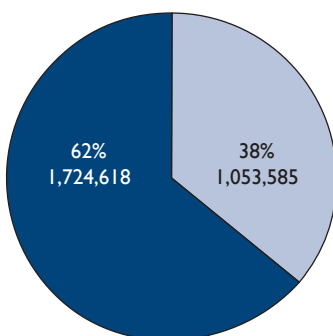

(Comparison of Missouri Public Higher Education Institutions)

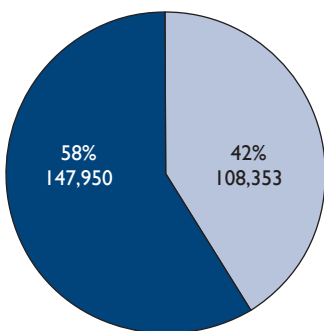

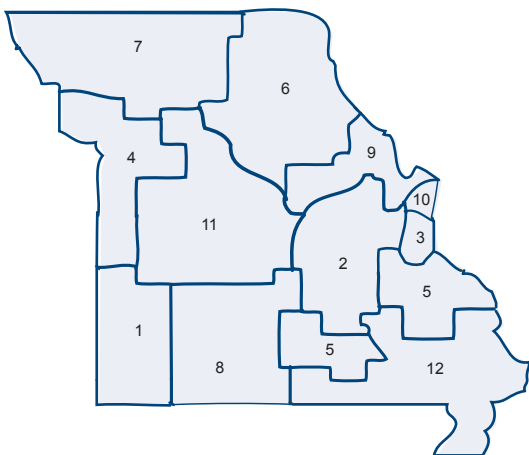
